- Free zoom talks from gardening experts all over the country
- Did you know one of our Barlaston members (briefly) held a Guinness World Record for the tallest ever teasel !!! Why not join the fun in the 'Tallest Teasel Competition' ?

Other potential ideas we can consider this year: Creation of a social 'Community gardening team', WhatsApp swappers & shopping group, tool amnesty (got spare unloved tools?), pot amnesty, library of gardening books, 'Harvest Celebration Party', plus lots more.

For launch night we'll first have a short introduction to the garden club, then we'll have a talk & demo from **10X Chelsea Gold Medal winning nursery PlantaGoGo** who specialise in **Heuchera, Heucherella, & Tiarella**s. You will probably have seen them on TV with Carol Klein & Joe Swift. They will be bringing plants for sale, so bring your debit/credit card.

We'll have regular meetings on Wednesdays in the Village Hall & on Tuesdays or Thursdays at The Parish Church. Having different days hopefully gives everyone a chance to attend some of the sessions. It's a beginners garden club so you don't need any experience whatsoever, it's open to everyone. On launch night enjoy an Indian Samosa (or two). Plus if you decide to join, pick up some **FREE** purple seed potatoes.





Hands on interactive workshops include: Activities like pruning & grafting family fruit trees. We run through 'Jobs to do for the month', & members share tips with each other in Q&A sessions. Plus we all know how therapeutic gardening can be for our mental wellbeing, so occasionally in the workshops we have a 'Share your Gloom & your Blooms' chat, which is my attempt to encourage well being conversations. We



ask everyone to bring in a Bloom or something that's looking good in their garden, & we take it in turn to firstly briefly share any Gloom we may have, then to follow up with a brief chat about what Blooms you have brought in to show, or something positive that you've been doing in the garden to lift your mood. It's completely optional, but gives people a chance to talk, open up, & build a connection within our group.

3 formats of open garden events:

1) **Autumn virtual open gardens** - During lockdown & in place of the main open gardens event, Barlaston residents shared clips of their gardens virtually in a video. So why not participate in the 2023 village video by taking a 60 second clip during the spring or summer of your garden & what you are growing? Open to anyone in the village. If possible, have someone from your household give an introduction/commentary at the start. Please record in landscape (horizontal view), in highest resolution. 2) **Main open garden event** - Our last event was in July 2019 with 25 gardens open, over 800 visitors & a GPS tracked Hopon Hopoff minibus service. If you'd like to participate in the 2023 event, please get in touch.

3) **Small local garden visits** - If the main open garden event sounds too daunting, then why not participate in the local garden visits. Over the last few years during covid (instead of the main event), we had small visits to members gardens, restricted to members only so we could manage numbers. This was very relaxed & really enjoyable as it meant villagers could invite neighbours round to their gardens, anytime they wished & it would only be a handful of people. You can pick which ever month, date & time that suits you best. So if you find at some point your garden is suddenly blooming & you wouldn't mind having a few of us around for a gander & chat, then just drop me a note. We're a friendly bunch....well....most of us are !!!

To Join: It's ALWAYS FREE to attend your first meeting, so why not come along to see if you like it first, bring along a friend for free too. If you want to join, it's just £20py & you can sign up in person at the meetings, or online on www.BVGClub.co.uk (check out the website for more info & join the mail list). We're cashless so payments are either; contactless card, chip&pin, QR code or via online bank transfer. If you use a smartphone, please download the 'SumUp Pay' app, this will really help during events.
